

Autumn Term



Maths

In Maths the children are learning about 'Place Value' including understanding the value of each digit, up to 4-digit numbers. The children will then progress onto 'Addition and Subtraction' using both the written column and mental methods.

You can help at home by regularly practising times tables ready for the multiplication check in June!

English

The children in Year 4 are learning about story writing. Learning to include a capital letter and full stop for each sentence. They will be writing character and setting descriptions based on stories about the rainforest and Ancient Maya.

Please ensure you are reading daily with your child and recording this in their Reading Record.

Science

The half term the children will be exploring how to classify organisms into groups based on their features.

They will then move onto their 'Digestion' topic. They will learn about the teeth, digestive system of humans, and different ecosystems and how they differ between species.

Geography & History

The children will be exploring the country of Brazil in Geography. They will learn where Brazil is in the world, about some key places within the country and how to locate on a map using lines of longitude and latitude.

In History, we will be introducing the children to the Ancient Maya civilisation including their beliefs and how they lived.

PSHE & RE

Children will be learning all about the truth in RE, including considering how the truth can look different to different people depending on the circumstances.

In PSHE, the children will discuss emotions and appropriate reactions to certain situations. We will also discuss differences and link this to discussions on how we treat others.

PE

PE day will be a Tuesday in Year 4 and the children will need to attend school in tracksuit bottoms, black/dark trainers, school polo top or t-shirt and a navy jumper.

Please ensure they have a bottle of water in school as well.
