

Autumn Term



Maths

In Maths the children will be learning about Place Value and working with numbers up to 10,000,000. They will extend their place value knowledge through the four operations and will secure formal methods for each.

Rapid recall of times tables facts are still key and will make maths easier for your child, please continue to practise at home.

English

The children in Year 6 are learning to write coherently with effective description and control. They will be using a range of clauses and phrases, including expanded noun phrases. They will be learning to write character and setting descriptions based on the book *Private Peaceful* by Michael Morpurgo.

Science

The half term we will be exploring Electricity. The children will be identifying and using different symbols within circuits. As well as getting to build and test their own circuits. We will also be looking at electricity in the home and renewable energy sources.

Geography & History

In Geography, we will be exploring how to protect the environment, looking at what we can do to slow down and reverse climate change and adapting to living with the changes that have taken place. In History we will be introducing the children World War I and the impact it had on modern Britain.

PSHE & RE

Children will be learning about how to manage different relationships and situations in PSHE. In RE we will be asking 'Why is the resurrection significant for Christians?' and 'Are religion and science in conflict?' We will be exploring these topics through religious artefacts, places and actions.

PE

PE day will be a Wednesday in Year 6 and the children will need to attend school in tracksuit bottoms, black/dark trainers, school polo top or t-shirt and a navy jumper. Please ensure they have a bottle of water too.
