

Spring Term



Maths

In Maths, the children will be building on their learning about Multiplication & Division. The children will be applying multiplication & division facts to solve a range of problems up to a 3-digit multiplied by a 1-digit number. You can help at home by continuing to practise times tables facts up to 12 x 12 to ensure these are secure.

English

The children in Year 4 are writing non-fiction texts this term. Our writing will be linked to our Geography unit with a newspaper report based on "The Explorer" and a non-fiction report on rainforests. Please ensure you are reading as much as possible with your child at home and encouraging them to discuss the texts they read!

Science

The half term we will be exploring 'States of Matter'. The children will be identifying properties of the states of matter and examining how particles differ in each state. We will then move on to our 'Sound' topic, learning about how we hear and how sound is produced.

Geography & History

We will be exploring 'Tropical Rainforests' in Geography, where they are, layers of rainforests, the importance of them and the effects of deforestation on our planet. In History, we are learning about the 'Early Islamic Empire', when & where they occurred in history, knowledge we still use today and links to the Islamic faith.

PSHE & RE

Children will be learning all about how to keep themselves safe in PSHE this term. We will discuss different risks and hazards and how to respond to dangerous situations. We will also look at how to keep healthy and safe, following rules and how to be respectful in different circumstances

PE
