

Spring Term



Maths

In Maths, the children will be completing their work on fractions before moving on to converting units. We will then be looking at decimals and how to convert between fractions, decimals and percentages. We will also be going over the work covered in Autumn term to review and prepare for our SATs.

English

The children in Year 6 are learning to write coherently with effective description and control. They will be using a range of clauses and phrases, including subordination and co-ordination. This term we will be focusing on non-fiction texts and children will be writing a non-chronological report and a newspaper report.

Science

This term we will be exploring light and classification of plants and animals. Children will learn about shadows, reflection and how the eye works. Children will then have the opportunity to classify different animals using their characteristics. We will be looking at plants, invertebrates and micro-organisms.

Geography & History

In Geography, we will be exploring migration, what it is and how it affects people. Children will learn what makes someone leave their home to start a new life. In History, we will be exploring who The Vikings were and what they believed in. They will find out how they made and traded goods across Europe and beyond.

PSHE & RE

Children will be learning how to keep safe in PSHE, looking at the effects of drugs and alcohol. Children will also learn about being respectful and democracy. In RE, we will be asking 'In what diverse ways do Hindus build a sense of community?' and 'What do philosophers teach us about life's purpose?' We will be exploring these topics through religious artefacts, places and actions.

PE

PE day will be a Wednesday in Year 6 and the children will need to attend school in tracksuit bottoms, black/dark trainers, school polo top or t-shirt and a navy jumper. Please ensure they have a bottle of water too.
