** Interpreting progress scores:

Progress scores will be centred around a score of 0, with most schools within the range of -5 to +5.

- **A score of 0** means pupils in the school on average do **as well** at KS2 as those with similar prior attainment nationally.
- **A positive score** means pupils in the school on average do **better** at KS2 as those with similar prior attainment.
- **A negative score** means pupils in the school on average do **worse** at KS2 as those with similar prior attainment nationally.
